### **Corowa Characters 46% ABV 500mL**

Corowa Characters pays homage to the four “lads” who make up the production team at Corowa Distilling Co. They are very serious about producing a world class product with a cheeky attitude that doesn’t take the industry, or themselves, as seriously. This whisky is combination of American, French, & Hungarian wine casks that have come together to produce a very approachable, flavoursome drink at a very attractive price point for an Australian single malt.

Nose: Spice, Oak, berries

Palate: Oak, toast, sweet fruit

Finish: Long and fruity



### **Mad Dog Morgan 46% ABV 500mL**

“Mad Dog Morgan” was a ruthless and bloodthirsty bushranger who roamed the southern riverine close to Corowa, famous for stealing the winner of the Melbourne Cup on 3 occasions. The town of Rutherglen, just across the Murray River from Corowa lays claim to some of the best fortified dessert wines in the world, particularly Muscat & Topaque. This whisky has been matured in American Oak Barrels that have previously contained this delicious Muscat wine.

Nose: Cinnamon, ginger honey, orange and floral notes

Palate: Oaky with spice, honey, orange, burnt caramel & raisins

Finish: Long & Sweet with a hint of vanilla



### **Bosque Verde 46% ABV 500mL**

The name Bosque Verde is Gaelic for “Green Grove” the name of the family farm for owners Neil & Dean Druce. It reflects the influence of a family business in the sometimes corporate world of the whisky production. These whiskies have been matured in American Oak barrels that have previously contained Australian fortified red wine (or Port).

Nose: Cherries, pear, raisins, spice, oak & hints of chocolate

Palate: Spicy, Cinnamon, nuttiness, malt, berries

Finish: Long and sweet, soft with a hint of vanilla



## Corowa Distillery Whisky Range (Federation Release)



### Private Notes 46% ABV 500mL

Corowa is the birthplace of Australian Federation, and it was Sir John Quick, who moved the motion at the 1893 people's conference held in Corowa, that the states come together to form a federated nation. Private Notes commemorates the diary he kept throughout the conference. This whisky has been aged in apera (Australian sherry) barrels.

Nose: Spicy, pear, honey

Palate: Honey, caramel, oak

Finish: vanilla, honey, and oak



### Quick's Courage 46% ABV 500mL

This whisky pays homage to the man who had the courage to move the pivotal motion that changed the face of politics in Australia. This whisky was first matured in American Oak Bourbon barrels before spending its final months in barrels from Spain that had contained the sweet, aged sherry called Pedro Ximenez.

Nose: Spicy, honey, pear and oak

Palate: Nutty, butterscotch, toffee

Finish: Long & sweet, vanilla and oak
